

Terms and conditions for Namaste World 2026

- 1. Every participating country team is supposed to be in Ahmedabad on 28th January 2026, the official program will be over by 05th February 2026.
- 2. The event will take place in both Bhuj and Ahmedabad. The program will be sent to you by mail as soon as we will be sure with every micro details of the event. The Namaste World Committee is responsible for taking care of your accommodation, food and travel during the event days.
- 3. We will provide you food, accommodation and transportation for the event days.
- 4. Each group is responsible for arranging its individual travel itinerary to Ahmedabad, Gujarat, India, and also for the return journey to its home country from Ahmedabad, Gujarat, India.
- 5. The size of the group can be a maximum of 25 people, including dancers, musicians, and leaders.
- 6. The minimum age of the performer should be 15 years.

- 7. The group should prepare various performances, and its time frame should be a minimum of 15 minutes up to a maximum of 30 minutes.
- 8. The group should be prepared to teach a traditional folk dance to the audience.
- 9. There will be different activities arranged for the group, including press conferences, receptions, social visits, and other activities.
- 10. No group will receive any type of insurance from us. Everyone must have insurance that protects both their health and their belongings for the duration of the journey, from the time they leave their home country until they return.
- 11. Guide will be provided for the group throughout the whole festival tour in India.
- 12. Namaste World Committee shall retain the rights to tape, record, and broadcast Namaste World festival events regarding performers during the period of the festival.
- 13. By participating in Namaste World, the performer(s) hereby grant permission for his/her performance video to be posted on www.namasteworldfest.in and/or all Namaste World social media and associated communications channels. Namaste World Committee is not responsible for any unauthorized third-party use of any entry.
- 14. No political or global movement symbols may be used during your visit to India, and the performances must never be offensive to any country, religion, public, or other competitors.
- 15. In any unfortunate circumstances, decisions such as changing the date, itinerary, or location of the festival, as well as postponement or cancellation of the festival, may be made by the Namaste World Committee. All legal disputes are "subject to the jurisdiction of the courts in Ahmedabad".
